**NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL SAFETY MAINTENANCE WORKS
Priory roundabout to M1 junction 25 – Eastbound and Westbound**

As you may be aware we are currently carrying out essential safety maintenance works to several sections along the A52 between the M1 Junction 25 and the A1 at Barrowby.

During our scheme of work, we are resurfacing several sections of the carriageway, refreshing road markings, installing high friction surfacing, replacing traffic detection loops, and renewing bridge joints.

In order to keep disturbances to a minimum, we are completing this work in phases.

How will the work affect traffic in your area?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and motorists, we will need to use a full night-time carriageway closure between the Priory roundabout and the M1 junction 25.

This closure will be in place as follows;

- **Westbound 16th February** until the **22nd February 2022**
- **Eastbound 23rd February** until the **4th March 2022**

All closures will be between the hours of **8pm** and **6am, Monday to Friday.**

Please note that all our planned works are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will this affect access to your property?

To ensure access to properties directly on the A52 between our closure extents are still available, we will put in place a traffic management team that can escort residents through our works.

Please be aware that for us to escort vehicles, there may be a slight delay to your journey while you wait for our site team to be available and escort you safely through our working zones. Please do not proceed through the road closure without a member of our site team.

If the access to your property does not front the A52, we will not be able to escort you through our closure and politely ask that you use the fully signed diversion route that will be in place.

All carriageways will be open as usual outside of our working hours.
